Located in the center of Tokyo, SWU is renowned for its history and excellence in the area of Japanese Language Teaching. The new program, offered in June and July, consists of 2 consecutive sessions, which are independent of each other and can be taken individually or in sequence. The class meets Monday through Friday for 2 or 3 weeks, and the class period (4:00 pm~ 7:30 pm JST) is convenient for different time zones worldwide, including Europe and Asia-Pacific.



## Requirements for Online Program (Basic I and II) ->

- 1) Must be an undergraduate or graduate student currently enrolled in a higher education institution outside of Japan.
- 2) Must have finished studying introductory-level Japanese.
  - e.g.) Studied Japanese for approximately 250-300hrs
    - Finished studying with the following textbooks:

「みんなの日本語 1 & 2 (Minna no Nihongo I &II)」

「げんき1&2 (GENKI: An Integrated Course in Elementary Japanese I &II )」

(Note) Students will be asked to take SPOT before applying. Depending on the SPOT result, SWU may ask students to start from a specific program instead of the program which they requested. For details on SPOT, please refer to the QR code.
